Dear friends of historical motorcycles,

Soon it will be time again: On 5 October 2019 the popular Motorbike Classics Meeting will take place for the 40th time on the open-air grounds of the Technik Museum Sinsheim. As always, we expect good weather, especially during our Joint Motorcycle Ride on the Friday before. Today you will finally receive the registration documents with the updated conditions of participation. Right at the beginning, we would like to briefly highlight the innovations compared to last year:

- *Admission to the exhibition halls of the Technik Museum Sinsheim is no longer included in the participation fee for the Motorbike Classics Meeting. However, we have reduced the entry fee considerably: The participation fee for this year's Motorbike Classics Meeting is €15.00 (members only €10.00)*
- *For the first time this year, we will send the participation documents by post after successful registration. These will be sent to all participants immediately after the registration deadline.*

Terms and Conditions of Participation

- Any motorcycle, moped, scooter and sidecar motorcycle with a minimum age of 30 years is eligible to participate.
- In order to take part in the Drive, the vehicle must also be road legal. Each driver must have a valid driving license.
- Participants do not have to take part in the Drive *and* Motorbike Classics Meeting but can register for only one of the two days.

Entry fee

- For the participation in the **Motorbike Classics Meeting, an entry fee of €15.00** (members €10.00) has to be paid. The entry fee includes participation in the vehicle evaluation, a professional photograph and admission to the Indian Wall of Death Show.
- For participation in the **Drive (Friday), an entry fee of €50.00** (members € 35.00) has to be paid. Passengers can be registered for €35.00. Included in the entry fee is a breakfast before the Drive, a lunch with a drink and a professional driver photo of the Drive. Participants who also take part in the Motorbike Classics Meeting the following day are invited by Museum President Hermann Layher to take part in the evening BBQ (from 7 pm, only if the weather is good).

Registration / Registration deadline

- **We recommend online-registration via www.technik-museum.de/motorbike-classics.** In this case the entry fee can be paid in advance or by credit card.
- Alternatively, the classic registration form at the end of this letter can also be used. The bank details for the transfer of the entry fee can be found on the form. Please refrain from sending cheques and cash!
- Registrations are only valid after we have confirmed them in writing by e-mail. We confirm registrations usually within 5 working days. We reserve the right to refuse registrations without giving reasons.
- The deadline for registration is Sunday 29 September 2019, by which time we must also have received the entry fee.
- Whether we will allow late registrations directly on the day of the event, please see the information on our website.
- Cancellations received after 29 September 2019 will not be refunded.

Participation documents

- At the end of September, we will send all participation documents (participation permit, data sheet and various vouchers) by post. Please make sure to provide a correct postal address when registering!

The following schedules are preliminary. The final schedule will be announced at the latest when the participation documents are sent out. We will also inform participants by e-mail in the event of major changes.
